Targets:

600 yard MR-1 and 600 yard MR-1FC

Course of Fire Day 1

Match 1 - 600yards, unlimited sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 25 minutes, prone
Match 2 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Match 3 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Day 1 Match - Aggregate of Matches 1, 2 and 3

Day 2

Match 4 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Match 5 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Match 6 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Day 2 Match - Aggregate of Matches 4, 5 and 6

Day 3

Match 7 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Match 8 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Match 9 - 600yards, 2 sighting shots, 20 rounds for record, in 22 minutes, prone
Day 3 Match - Aggregate of Matches 7, 8 C 9

Grand Aggregate Match - Aggregate of Day 1, Day 2 and Day 3

Awards:

- First, second and third overall by rifle type - not eligible for any other awards
- First, second and third class awards, i.e. HM, MA, EX, SS, MK, by rifle type - not eligible for any other awards
- First, second and third category awards - (rifle types may be combined) - Senior, Grand Senior, Woman, Veteran, Police and Junior; one age category per competitor.
- 5 competitors required for first place, 10 competitors required for second place, 15 competitors required for third place
- Classes may be combined, except for High Master.
- Match awards will be presented the next day at the morning briefing.
- All competitors are eligible for Cold Bore X coins - A Cold Bore X is the first round shot for the day in the "X" ring , on your target.

Scoring:

All competitors are required to score. The Shot Marker Targeting System will be used. Competitors should bring an electronic device capable of connecting to the Range WiFi, accessing a webpage by IP address with sufficient power for at least 5 hours.

Scorekeepers - Scorekeepers are Match Officials. Scorekeepers must immediately report any extra shots, crossfires, or missing shots. All rounds must be accounted for.

Competitors - Competitors should stop, and ensure the scorekeeper reports any extra shots, crossfires, or missing shots. All rounds must be accounted for. Failure to do so will result in the competitor accepting the shot. There are no provisional shots.

Duties C Responsibilities:

- Competitors are strongly encouraged to wear eye protection and hearing protection
- Open Bolt indicators are required
- Rifles with weight restrictions must be weighed before the first shot is fire
- Competitors are expected to remove all their equipment from the firing line when match is complete
- Sighters are not convertible. Sighters are unlimited only on the first match.
- Competitors requiring assistance moving equipment should inform the Match Director prior to the start of the matches. Medical Waivers should be presented prior to the start of the match.
- Temperatures can be anywhere from 40's to 80's. The 600 yard line is covered, competitors will be sheltered from rain, but not heat. Bring fluids and snacks.
- On site camping is available for \$10.00 a night, electric only. This tends to fill up. Call and ensure there is room before making plans.
- Competitors should have a good 600yd zero to enter this match.
- MidRange, FClass MidRange and AR-Tact classification will be used. If there is a question, be prepared to present your classification card. The classification card also has your NRA ID number or member number on it.
- Challenge Period is immediately after the last shot is fired for the day. The challenge period is 30 minutes. The scores are posted on the white board under the pole barn.
- Competitors sharing equipment must note that on the entry form

Challenges - asking for a check on the shot value is called a "challenge", Rule 16.1, (this includes "I don't shoot 8's")

- A challenge costs \$3 - exact change only, no pennies.
- If the competitor is proven correct, the \$3 will be returned.
